ORDINANCE No. 12-11

AMENDING ORDINANCE

04-02-A

Adopted on February 18,
2004

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Maurice,
Louisiana, acting as the governing authority of said Village that:

“Within 30 minutes of the designated closing time outlined in this Ordinance, all patrons of any and all businesses whose primary business is to sell alcohol shall be removed and physically out of the establishment. Furthermore, no business transactions regarding the sale of any alcoholic beverages shall take place at any moment after the designated closing time. Whoever is in charge of operating and/or running the business establishment who violates this Ordinance shall be issued a misdemeanor summons to appear before the Magistrate Court of the Village of Maurice.”
