**AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING THE MAGISTRATE JUDGE
TO INCREASE FINES FOR CHARGES UNDER TITLE 14**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Maurice,
Louisiana, acting as the governing authority of said Village:

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Maurice do hereby introduce an ordinance wherein the governing body with judicial authority shall be allowed to increase any fines associated with any and all criminal charges outlined under Title 14 for any and all misdemeanors that lie within Title 14 of up to \$500 or imprisonment of 6 months or more.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
